- Introductions and Announcements
- Curb cuts – Last Spring, the PSC was asked to provide input on “a proposed ordinance to expand upon the factors considered when granting a curb entrance in order to address the impacts to Town streets and properties from current and proposed development adjacent to the Town”. The PSC Chair responded that a) a Bond be required for any work in a Town right of way and b) that some of the language be “softened and broadened to apply to all properties within and along the borders of the Town”.
- John Bickerman – The October Council Meeting has been moved to October 13th (tonight) so John will be unable to attend the PSC meeting; the next Council Meeting will be on November 9th
- Discuss the traffic issues in the vicinity of CCES; request was made for a wider Town wide traffic study; collect data to establish a “baseline” for traffic counts before new development kicks in. Todd to discuss this with (Mayor) Scott Fosler
- Streetlights and Streetlight Requests – The Town is currently processing a request for the 7600 block of Meadow Lane; two (2) street lights have been installed at that location; no other requests have been received
- Currently, the Neighborhood Watch committee (NWC) is under the Community Relations Committee umbrella. Wicca Davidson is suggesting that she thinks that it should be under the PSC. The PSC is not opposed to this however; it will be up to the Council to authorize this switch/change. This was brought up again at the meeting of the Committee Chairs held on October 4th
- PSC made recommendation to Todd/Council to install a pole light (similar to the ones installed on E-W Hwy.) in the Willow Lane Park near the existing bench. On September 8th Dave Walton advised that they had the necessary cost proposals for the work and the cost is higher than originally thought due to a new meter being required and running the power underground from an existing pole. Dave advised that Todd plans to check with the Council to see if they are willing to authorize the unbudgeted expense
