- Street lights and streetlight requests- PSC recommended that no streetlight be installed at 7110 Beechwood. Request for new light at corner of Leland/44<sup>th</sup> Street is being handled by the Town Office
- Purple Line & Lynn Drive underpass; E-W Hwy safety (Council/PLMC ongoing)
