- Rosemary & Connecticut – PM rush hour traffic – Future study
- Meadow Lane & EW Hwy – 7709 (Carlos & Teresa Salcedo) & 7710 Meadow (Tom Kelsey & Chantelle Kimm) – Joe Cutro has made a preliminary study of this intersection and signage; report to be issued
- Consider speed bump on East between Stanford & Walsh after Cutro improvements implemented and after moratorium
- Speed bump moratorium implemented; PSC to make recommendation to Council by end of April. PSC discussion this meeting
- Neighborhood Watch Program – Council asked that we make one more appeal for block captains; Notice published in Forecast and Town Crier; 6 volunteers so far. PSC will recommend that the NWP be suspended due to lack of volunteers. NWP signage to remain in place. PSC Chair to thank those individuals who volunteered
- Discussion of temporary bike trail thru the Town
- Purple Line & Lynn Drive underpass; E-W Hwy safety (Council/PLMC ongoing)
