- This meeting is open to all Town residents
- East-West Hwy – Safety improvements – lane narrowing; new pavement markings; pruning of resident shrubbery protruding over sidewalk
- Discussion of Joe Cutro’s report (7.18.18) on the signage/safety at Meadow & E-W Hwy
- Recommendation for new Town wide traffic study – PSC recommendation to “hold” on any study until utility construction has been completed in 2019
- Rosemary & Connecticut – PM rush hour traffic – Future study
- PSC to follow up with Todd on safety recommendation(s) at Leland & East
- Discussion of enhanced parking enforcement at Town borders and parking passes; discuss the process for issuing Town parking passes (now every 2 years) and number of passes per household (1 per household currently). A resident may request additional passes which are good for only 1 month and need to be reissued after that period of time
- The PSC has endorsed and the Town Council has approved the new speed hump policy. This has been posted on the Town’s website
- Neighborhood Watch Program – The PSC has recommended that the NWP be suspended due to lack of volunteers. It is our understanding that the Council agrees with this. The NWP signage will remain in place
- Discussion of ongoing complaints at Maple/Aspen intersection; Discussion on Zimmerman Park safety improvements for B-CC HS students
- Purple Line & Lynn Drive underpass
- B-CC CAT (Community Advisor Team) – Purple Line
