COUNCIL MEETING

July 13, 2016

*This is a summary of the Council's actions at the July 13, 2016 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.*

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Approved minutes of June 8, 2016 Council Meeting & Executive Session.
- Accepted June 2016 financial report.
- Reviewed Town Manager's report.
- Heard public comments.

II. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS

- Discussed issues related to Purple Line mitigation. Voted unanimously to appropriate \$10,000 for consultation services to assist the Town's Special Committee on Purple Line Mitigation in developing a plan for mitigation efforts. Agreed that the Committee's objectives should include ensuring safe access to and from the Capital Crescent Trail and proposing funding sources for related expenses. Discussed preparing comments for a Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement if the opportunity arises.
- Discussed issues related to the Bethesda Downtown Plan. Approved the submission of two letters from the Town to the Planning Board. Agreed to schedule a community meeting on the Bethesda Downtown Plan and to disseminate information to the community on issues related to the plan. Agreed to task the Town's Long Range Planning Committee with following and reporting on updates to Montgomery County's Subdivision Staging Policy. Discussed use of legal counsel in support of Town efforts.
- Discussed a proposed Stormwater Management and Erosion and Sediment Control Ordinance. Voted unanimously to submit the ordinance to the State for review and to apply for erosion and sediment enforcement authority from the State. Agreed to hold a future work session on the ordinance.
- Voted unanimously to approve a request from the Montgomery County Board of Elections to suspend permit parking restrictions around the Lawton Center during the General Election early voting period from October 27 to November 3.

III. PUBLIC HEARINGS & COUNCIL ACTIONS

- Voted unanimously to approve an ordinance granting a non-exclusive cable franchise to Starpower Communications, LLC.
