

TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE
COUNCIL MEETING
TOWN HALL
April 24, 2019

This is a summary of the Council's actions at the April 24, 2019 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Voted unanimously to approve minutes of March 13 Council Meeting; March 20 Work Session; April 4 Closed Meeting, as amended; April 4 Work Session; and April 4 Council Meeting.
- Discussed and accepted March 2019 financial report.
- Approved a supplemental appropriation of \$30,000 for executive search firm fee and associated expenses.
- Heard and discussed Town Manager's report.
- Heard general public comments.

II. PUBLIC HEARINGS

- Held a public hearing and voted unanimously to adopt an ordinance, as amended, to modify the Town's permit parking regulations.

III. COUNCIL ACTIONS

- Introduced an ordinance to adopt the FY20 Budget and Tax Rates.
- Voted unanimously to approve a resolution to designate permit parking on Oak Lane between Leland Street and Ridgewood Avenue.

IV. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS

- Held a discussion and voted unanimously to introduce an ordinance, as amended, to modify the Town building code.
- Zimmerman Park Amenities & Improvements
 - Discussed the status of the Lee Dennison Sustainable Garden requests for proposals
 - Voted unanimously to appropriate \$10,500 for Phase 1 engineering work related to the development of a feasibility study for a proposed stairway and pathway, and to appropriate \$50,500 for Phase 2 engineering work related to the development of detailed documents for permitting and construction. Voted unanimously to retain an engineering firm to begin the feasibility study.
 - Received an update on the status of the concept master plans.
- Project Updates:
 - Discussed the status of the East West Highway traffic calming efforts.
 - Discussed the status of the Town's Purple Line mitigation efforts.
 - Discussed the status of the Bethesda Downtown Plan Implementation.
 - Discussed the status of the installation of the East Avenue speed radar board.
 - Received an update on the Town-wide traffic study. Voted unanimously to appropriate funds and approve a proposal to authorize the Town's consulting traffic engineer to prepare the request for proposals.
 - Received an update on the activities of the Town Climate and Environment subcommittees.
