

**TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE
COUNCIL MEETING

November 9, 2016**

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Approved minutes of October 13, 2016 Council Meeting & Executive Session.
- Accepted October 2016 financial report.
- Approved FY16 operating budget transfers.
- Heard and discussed Town Manager's report.
- Heard public comments.

II. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS

- Discussed issues and efforts related to the Bethesda Downtown Plan and Montgomery County's Subdivision Staging Policy.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Purple Line mitigation. Voted unanimously to direct the Town's Special Committee on Purple Line Mitigation to draft a letter requesting that no waivers from federal law be provided to the Purple Line project. Voted 4-1, with Councilmember Bickerman opposed, to direct the Special Committee on Purple Line Mitigation to draft comments, to be reviewed by Mayor Fosler, on MTA's permit applications related to stormwater management and forest conservation.

III. VARIANCE HEARINGS

- Voted unanimously to approve a variance for driveway width, number of garage doors and garage offset at 4509 Leland Street.
- Voted unanimously to approve a variance for front and side yard setbacks at 7404 Ridgewood Avenue.
