

**TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE  
COUNCIL MEETING  
TOWN HALL  
February 12, 2018**

*This is a summary of the Council's actions at the February 12, 2018 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.*

**I. GENERAL BUSINESS**

- Approved minutes of January 10, 2018 Council meeting and January 11, 2018 work session.
- Accepted January 2018 financial report.
- Heard and discussed Town Manager's report.

**II. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON FY19 BUDGET PRIORITIES**

- Heard public comments on FY19 budget priorities.

**III. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS & PRESENTATIONS**

- Heard proposal from Town resident Irene Lane to form a Climate and Environment Advisory Group and establish an annual Town "Green Fair" event. Voted unanimously to appropriate \$1,000 for the 2018 event. Discussed the possibility of signing on to the Paris Climate Accord and the need to develop specific commitment language that is achievable for the Town.
- Discussed certain changes to Town building regulations as proposed by the Town's Land Use Committee. Voted unanimously to introduce an ordinance, as revised, to amend the Town building code.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Purple Line mitigation, including establishing an alliance with other local municipalities to address issues of mutual interest; review of stormwater management and civil plans; public safety; the Lynn Drive underpass; and the proposed Capital Crescent interim trail.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to implementation of the Bethesda Downtown Plan, including pending property redevelopments and the need for legal assistance in reviewing and responding to development plans. Agreed to allocate Town funds for legal assistance and to increase public awareness of redevelopment applications.
