

TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE
COUNCIL MEETING
TOWN HALL
March 13, 2019

This is a summary of the Council's actions at the March 13, 2019 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Voted unanimously to approve minutes of February 2019 Council meeting.
- Discussed and accepted February 2019 financial report.
- Heard and discussed Town Manager's report.
- Heard general public comments.
- Heard public comments on FY20 budget priorities.

II. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS

- Heard and discussed proposed changes to the Town building code. Agreed to hold a work session on March 20 to continue discussion of the proposed changes.
- Discussed and voted unanimously to introduce an ordinance to amend the Town's permit parking regulations. A public hearing will be held at the April 24 Council meeting.
- Discussed Zimmerman Park amenities and improvements. Voted unanimously to expend a maximum of \$5,000 to develop two conceptual master plans of proposed improvements.
- Discussed East West Highway safety, including lane narrowing, construction of a pathway and staircase through Zimmerman Park, and deployment of temporary speed cameras.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Bethesda Downtown Plan implementation, including proposed development on and around the Farm Women's Market site.
- Discussed traffic and pedestrian safety on East Avenue. Voted unanimously to expend a maximum of \$4,000 to acquire a radar speed board as a temporary traffic calming measure.
- Discussed the Climate and Environment Advisory Group's 2019 work plan.
- Discussed the status of State legislation regarding small cell facilities.
- Discussed the status of County legislation regarding accessory dwelling units.
- Discussed the status of planning for a Town-wide traffic study.

III. ADJOURNMENT

- The meeting was adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
