This is a summary of the Council's actions at the April 23, 2018 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Voted unanimously to approve minutes of March 19, 2018 Council work session and meeting.
- Accepted March 2018 financial report.
- Accepted Town Manager's Report
- Heard public comments.

II. DISCUSSIONS & PRESENTATIONS

- Heard and discussed presentation by Montgomery County Department of Transportation officials and consultants on proposed Capital Crescent Trail tunnel, surface route and interim route. Voted unanimously to schedule a work session, to include a public comment period, followed by a separate public hearing on these matters.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Purple Line mitigation. Voted unanimously to direct the Town Manager to identify potential expert advisors and consultants to assist the Town in reviewing and responding to technical documents related to the Purple Line.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Bethesda Downtown Plan implementation.
- Heard and discussed report from Climate and Environment Committee regarding a proposed teaching garden project. Voted unanimously to approve the concept and to encourage the Climate and Environment Committee to develop an implementation proposal for presentation to the Town Council.
