

TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE
COUNCIL MEETING
TOWN HALL
July 11, 2018

This is a summary of the Council's actions at the July 11, 2018 Council meeting. Detailed meeting minutes are posted once they are approved by the Town Council at the next regular Council meeting.

I. GENERAL BUSINESS

- Voted unanimously to approve minutes of June 2018 Council meeting.
- Discussed and accepted June 2018 financial report. Treasurer to create task force to research investment opportunities for Town reserve funds.
- Heard and discussed Town Manager's report.
- Heard public comments.

II. VARIANCE HEARINGS

- Voted unanimously to approve a variance for a garage door offset at 4403 Elm Street.

III. COUNCIL DISCUSSIONS & PRESENTATIONS

- Discussed a partnership opportunity with Chevy Chase at Home. Voted unanimously to undertake a campaign to encourage awareness of the organization among the Town's elderly and disabled residents; to hear from the Community Liaison at the Council's September meeting regarding plans for this campaign; and to provide \$5,000 to support the organization's general operations.
- Heard and discussed presentations on a proposed dog exercise area and sustainable garden in Zimmerman Park. Discussed a process of soliciting public input to develop a master plan for the park. Agreed to hold a community forum in the fall on possible changes in uses of the park.
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Purple Line mitigation, including noise mitigation and pedestrian safety improvements along East West Highway
- Discussed issues and efforts related to Bethesda Downtown Plan implementation, including possible creation of additional parkland adjacent to the Town.
- Agreed to ask the Town's Special Committee on Purple Line Mitigation at its next meeting to consider a resident's request to retain an attorney to assist with the Town's Purple Line mitigation efforts.
