Pepco

The Task Force reviewed performance data and a map of system improvements provided by Pepco. The Task Force decided to ask Pepco for additional information regarding the 5 circuits that serve the TOCC. The Task Force wanted to understand how the performance of the 5 circuits serving TOCC compared to both Pepco's other circuits and the performance standards established by the State. Grant will circulate questions to Task Force members for review and input before asking Eric to forward them on to Pepco, and then the Task Force will invite Pepco representatives to attend its next meeting and address the questions.

Pepco-Exelon Merger

The Task Force recommended that the TOCC Council register as an interested party at the merger hearing with the Maryland Public Service Commission.

Microgrid

The Task Force has decided to review the potential of microgrids and other distributed generation options with providers of these services. Steve Seidel reported on his outreach to NRG. The Task Force will invite NRG to attend an upcoming Task Force meeting.

It was suggested that in addition to outlining options for the town to embark upon as a whole, the Task Force's report might include a list of steps that individual residents can take at their homes to improve power reliability.
