

**Town of Chevy Chase  
Long Range Planning Committee  
Monday, October 7, 2019

Committee members introduced themselves, Town committee rules were reviewed.

The projects the committee will focus on this coming year were reviewed. These include: 1) selected development projects in Bethesda; 2) the county's Pedestrian Master Plan; 3) the county's 2020 update of the 2016 Subdivision Staging Policy (SSP), 4) the Bethesda Urban Mobility Program (BUMP); and 5) Thrive Montgomery 2050, the revision of the county's General Plan.

The committee discussed the 7121 Wisconsin-FWM site-Parking Lots 10 & 24 project as presented by EYA on October 3 at a Town forum sponsored by the committee. The committee generally considered the current plan to be a great improvement over the earlier plan. They noted the need to monitor details of the project as they develop, (including exterior lighting, location of loading and trash zones for both the apartment building and the market buildings), park amenities and plans for programming and maintenance, and construction staging issues. The committee also noted that raising funds to cover the transformation of Lots 10 and 24 into parks will be important and the Town will probably need to play a role in this process.

John Freedman reviewed the state's Open Meetings rules which govern how the committee operates.
