**RESOLUTION OF  
THE TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE**

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MONTGOMERY COUNTY  
HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN 2013**

WHEREAS, the Town of Chevy Chase recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 5121, et seq., and the implementing regulations thereto, local governments are required to develop a hazard mitigation plan as a condition for receiving disaster mitigation grant funding; and


WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Council, by Resolution 17-832, adopted the Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2013 (dated July 30, 2013); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chevy Chase finds that adopting the Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2013 would promote the good government of the Town and protect and preserve the Town's rights, property, and privileges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2013, by the Council of the Town of Chevy Chase that:

1. The Town of Chevy Chase hereby adopts the Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan 2013, as adopted by the Montgomery County Council by Resolution 17-832; and
2. This resolution is effective as of November 13, 2013.
