Dear Secretary Rahn,

As you know, notifying those who will be impacted by Purple Line construction of potential impacts as far in advance as possible will be critically important to the communities that will be affected by the work for the next four to five years. Part 2A, Section 13.4 of the Technical Provisions in the P3 Agreement requires, "Written notification of commencement of work in an area a maximum of 60 days but not less than 30 days in advance of the operation or activity."

It has, however, come to my attention today that the 30-day advance notification requirement of the commencement of work on the Purple Line project has been modified to seven days. Please provide all documents that show this modification.

I would also appreciate if the state could publish this change *and any other changes* to the P3 Agreement on the official Purple Line website. The public deserves to know what is required of the private concessionaire responsible for building this project.

Thank you for your work in advancing the Purple Line to this point. I look forward to your response.
