Meeting Minutes

The meeting was “in-person” at the Lawton Center and was called to order by the chair at 7:20 p.m.

The minutes of the May 16, 2023 meeting were approved. The Chair distributed the minutes of the June 12, 2023 Town of Chevy Chase Council Meeting minutes, a list of resident comments, including four new comments from the Safe Streets Community Project, and Action Notes in response to selected comments.

One-way traffic on 46<sup>th</sup> Street south of Leland was discussed. The PSC recommends the change of direction of one-way traffic, however the implementation of the recommendation requires additional information about Purple Line construction and the Lot 10 Market Plan. WSSC input and the holding of a public forum are also necessary.

The drying up of Coquelin Run was discussed. The Maryland Department of the Environment has an essential role in the solution of the problem.

Stop lights have been approved for East/West Highway at Chatham Road and Edgevale Road. Installation is scheduled for mid-2024.

Comments about the Safe Streets Community Project were reviewed and notes of thanks will be sent to all those submitting comments. Further engaging residents at the Fall Festival and the fall Trash and Treasures through the distribution of signs and badges was considered.

To place the current traffic and safety concerns in historical context, access to traffic studies over the last twenty years will be made available.

There are a few streets in the town without sidewalks. Requirements for sidewalk installation were reviewed.

A Zoom meeting with Todd Hoffman will be arranged to discuss traffic and safety within the town.

The next meeting of the PSC will be held by Zoom on July 18, 2023.
