CONSERVATION PROGRAM RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Article IX, Section 901 of the Town Charter, the town may acquire real property for any "public purpose" by purchase, gift, lease or other means; and

WHEREAS, the preservation of open space, the protection of environmentally sensitive areas, the preservation and enhancement of the town's existing tree canopy and the preservation of the character of the town are all public purposes


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town Council for the Town of Chevy Chase hereby adopts a Conservation Program whereby town residents may either offer to convey land in fee simple to the town or enter into conservation easements under which the town is the named beneficiary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT any offer made under this conservation program is subject to the review and approval by the Town Council for the Town of Chevy Chase.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Town Council for the Town of Chevy Chase may adopt and modify, at its discretion, any property eligibility criteria in considering the acceptance of real property under this program.


