- Evaluate existing service amenities (e.g., traffic, sidewalks, parking enforcement).
- Consider new service amenities and implement, if appropriate.
- Educate residents about community safety and preparedness -- coordinate with the Community Relations Committee.
- Develop ideas with other committees to support community aging in place.

Special Tasks for '14-'15

- Determine options for purchase of street lights and implementing new technologies.
- Work with the Town Council regarding review of traffic at Lawton Center
- Work with the Town Council and staff to review emergency vehicle access on Town streets.
